



HIMB Education COVID-19 Site Requirements

The Hawai'i Institute of Marine Biology is a part of the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa and we follow the [University's Guidelines for Visitors](#) and particularly the [UH – Mānoa Guidelines](#)

All visitors entering a University Site must provide proof of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19 (you have received all recommended COVID-19 vaccines, and we strongly suggest any booster dose when eligible) or, if youth under 12, provide proof of a Negative COVID-19 test within 3 days of the event from a [UH- recognized testing facility](#).

You may do this by doing one of the following:

- **Preferred:** Use the UH-Manoa [Lumisight UH](#) app and check in with the app that day (a COVID-19 Health questionnaire is included in the app)
- If unable to use the UH-Manoa [Lumisight UH](#) app, on the day of your visit, present your valid Vaccination card, ID, and fill out our printed Lumisight COVID Health Questionnaire
- For Children under 12 years of age that have not been vaccinated, you can present a current and valid negative COVID-19 test result and fill out our printed Lumisight COVID Health Questionnaire the day of your visit.

Note - Testing must be done within 3 days of the program from a [UH-recognized testing facility](#).

We do not accept self-tests or at-home COVID-19 tests.

ONCE ON SITE

- Continue to use Social Distancing for people outside of your family bubble.
- Masks are required indoors and outdoors where social distancing is not easily done (Since our walking tours require that we be close together to hear and see, we wear masks even outdoors on the tours).

Please do not use athletic neck gaiters, bandanas or crochet material (too thin and porous to be effective), or vented masks.

Our island institute is one of the only places in the world that has priceless continuous coral research spanning decades, so we take extra care not to have to shut down or slow the research due to quarantine issues.
